


“But these organizations do good things. My donation is going to good things.”

## Following the Money

### CUFI

- Over half a billion dollars has been taken in to CUFI (minimum estimate available)
- Not one penny has gone to share the gospel with the Jewish people
- US governmental lobby. Less than \$500,000 over the last 4 years.

Perhaps the most alarming fact regarding CUFI and money is that sheer lack of information. It is impossible to find out how much and where the money is being spent. One expenditure on which it is certainly being spent is to woo American pastors with free trips to Israel. CUFI's sub-organization called the "Israel Collective" is a wing which gives free trips to pastors and evangelical leaders in order to sway favor. All the while these leaders often have no idea that CUFI is sponsoring the trip and as policy hold animosity against sharing the gospel with Jewish people. Why is an organization claiming to be a friend of Israel withholding the very thing a Christian is commanded to do? Answer: The only thing "Christian" about CUFI is the title.

(Christians United For Israel)

- Have made agreements with Israeli leaders that they will not share the Gospel
- Actively discriminate against Jewish Believers
- Not run by Christians in any way

- "Jesus never claimed to be the Messiah." - John Hagee
- "CUFI called the Jewish Agency and tried to have me shut down because I am a Messianic Jew." - CUFI victim of persecution

## Truth about IFCJ

(International Fellowship of Christians and Jews)

- Not run by Christians in any way. The founder, the late Yechiel Eckstein, was an Orthodox Rabbi
- Have taken in over 1 Billion dollars, none of which goes to help Jewish Believers in Yeshua
- Use Christian language to sound like they are Messianic believers
- Yael Eckstein refuses to work with or hire Jews who actually believe in Jesus
- The IFCJ has no written Statement of Faith
